Mixed Local Election Results

The outcome of the Borough Election on the 3 May was disappointing with the WLBC Group losing 2 seats, Burscough East in our Constituency and North Meols in the South Ribble Constituency. Ruth Melling, Association

President, was an excellent councillor, very active within her local community and despite a hard fought campaign lost by only 31 votes.

Elsewhere, the results were much more encouraging with Doreen Stephenson substantially increasing her majority in



South West Lancashire Conservative Partnership

At the AGM in March it was agreed that our Association would work in partnership with the Southport, South Ribble, Chorley and Preston Associations to improve campaigning, attract more members and increase fundraising. The Party have provided and are paying for George Rear, an experienced full time professional Campaign Manager who is now based at Glover House.

The Chairmen from the 5 Associations recently held their first formal meeting and agreed the following:

- The name of the new organisation was to be the South West Lancashire Conservative Partnership and the Governing Document was to be a Memorandum of Understanding rather than a Constitution as both of these better reflect it is a partnership of independent associations rather than a multi constituency association.
- Chairman David Westley (West Lancs)
- Vice-Chairman Political Harry Bliss (Southport)
- Vice Chairman Fundraising Michael Green (South Ribble)
- Vice Chairman Treasurer Andy Pratt (Preston)
- Vice Chairman Membership Andy Riggett (Chorley)

As not an MCA there will be no membership levy on the constituent associations.

SWLCP will generate income from its fundraising activities e.g. an annual dinner, business club, patrons and donations.

I am working with George to produce a Draft Memorandum of Understanding and a Business Plan that after consideration by the other chairmen will go to the inaugural meeting of the Partnership's Executive Council for approval.

Chairman's message to Members

The uncertainty over the Brexit negotiations and the real threat posed by Jeremy Corbyn and Momentum to the future of our country make it essential that we in West Lancashire do everything possible to ensure the Conservative Party retain power.

The prospects of our returning a Conservative MP for West Lancashire may seem remote but it is possible as you only need to consider the progress the Party is making in Scotland that was once a Labour heartland. The new South West Lancashire Conservative Partnership is a very positive development and the benefit of having George Rear based in Glover House is already apparent. The 5 associations working together with professional support will make a tremendous difference and augers well for the future both in local and parliamentary elections.

Labour are strong in West Lancs and enormously helped by Rosie Cooper's staff who specialise in public relations and at election time the huge amount of manpower they bring in from Merseyside. By us mounting effective campaigns we make West Lancashire a key battleground for Labour and provide help to our two neighbouring Conservative MPs — Damien Moore in Southport and Seema Kennedy in South Ribble.


