LABOURS NEW LOCAL PLAN

Labour's intention to scrap the existing Local Plan is crazy. It still has 9 years to run, is meeting local housing need and has withstood legal challenges in respect of rogue developments. They want to replace it with a completely new Local Plan covering an unprecedented 30 years. A Plan that includes:

- A plan for a Greater Skelmersdale
- 15.992 new homes for West Lancashire
- 1,500 acres of Greenbelt to be lost
- Massive new industrial estates
- 6,256 homes to meet Merseyside's needs

Labour also want to ditch the established practice of safeguarding sites identified for future development. This would mean the Council abdicating its responsibility to manage the release of sites and allow developers, or as Labour say the "market", to decide which sites should be developed first. It would also mean that all the sites needed for the next 30 years would be made available for development from 2020.

Apart from wanting a huge increase in the annual target for both house building and commercial development, Labour want to provide land to meet the housing and commercial development needs of Merseyside - 6,256 new homes and hundreds of acres of new industrial estates.

The official figure for population growth in West Lancashire is 6,000 by 2041 and this can be met by the existing Local Plan yet Labour want to triple this rate of growth by attracting large numbers into the Borough from neighbouring areas.

The Conservatives insist that land for future housing in the Borough should be strictly limited to that required to meet the local need with the maximum use being made of brownfield sites. Releasing Greenbelt land should only be done as a last resort.

Labour's plans are irresponsible and if implemented, would have a devastating impact right across West Lancashire. They simply do not appreciate the importance of our greenbelt.

Chairman's Message

Labour have published their proposals for a new Local Plan that will have a hugely detrimental impact on West Lancashire. The Association and the Conservative Councillors consider it a major election issue and are actively campaigning against the proposals.
