He concluded that the Local Plan is sound and legally compliant, subject to his recommended modifications. A consultation on the changes recommended by Mr Clews was carried out during the summer. These have been incorporated into the modified Local Plan document which will be considered for adoption by Council on 16 October 2013.

## North West Candidate Selections for MEP Elections

The Conservative Party in the North West has picked its eight candidates for the European Parliamentary Elections in May 2014. Its follows a party ballot of Conservative Party members to rank candidates for the region - which comprises Cheshire, Cumbria, Greater Manchester, Lancashire and Merseyside. Jacqueline Foster MEP topped the ballot. Full details on the WLCA Website.

- Ormskirk's third Motorfest brought power to the people as thousands of visitors crowded into the town to celebrate everything that's great about cars and bikes on the 25th August.
- ♦ Exciting and innovative new recreation facilities are the latest youth attraction in Coronation Park as result of funding made available by the Conservative Borough Council. Project costs of £30,000 for the new facilities were raised by the Council through developer contributions from nearby housing sites. Edward McCarthy the candidate for Knowsley ward in next year's borough council elections said "I am delighted that pupils from Ormskirk School have been consulted on what new equipment should go into the park. I am sure many young people from across West Lancs will enjoy using these new facilities in Coronation Park. It is great that the new play equipment has been funded from contributions from nearby developments. The Conservative Council has invested and improved the park a great deal since taking office in 2002."
- West Lancashire Borough Council is urging local people and organisations to give their views on a package of measures of savings, efficiencies and increases in income, before the consultation closes on 11 September. People and organisations can give their views through the Your Views section of the borough council website. Comments can also be submitted by letter or email. The closing date is on Wednesday 11 September.
- Earlier in August West Lancashire parks retained their prestigious Green Flags.
- Community groups and individuals across West Lancashire have been given almost £7,000 worth of funding by the Conservative Borough Council earlier in June.
- ♦ In June Conservative controlled West Lancashire Borough Council has unveiled its new CCTV surveillance suite at a secret location. The new suite has the latest infra-red technology and will be the hub for security, overseeing an eventual total of 86 cameras all over the borough. In a project costing £360,000, the council has replaced all of its 59 existing cameras and will install a further 27 later this year.
- Election Results, from May the Conservatives won in West Lancs East, West Lancs South and West Lancs North. We did not win in West Lancs West, Skelmersdale West, Skelmersdale East or Skelmersdale Central. Labour won the borough council Digmoor by election. Thank-you to everyone who helped.
- There have been many summer West Lancs Conservative branch events, thank-you to everyone who went and everyone who helped.
